Divisions: Primary Novice, Primary Open, Secondary Open.
We will consider a Secondary B Division if numbers permit.

Format: *The Draw is decided by computer, using 'Swiss Perfect' and
played in 'Swiss' format.

*There will be 7 rounds and all players play all rounds.

*Where clocks are used, 15 minutes each is the standard.

All schools from the Sunshine Coast region are welcome,
Home-schoolers included.

- **Teams:** 4 players of any age within a Primary or Secondary division.

Part teams/extra players welcome ~ no student need miss out.

Team members listed in order of playing strength.

- **Entries:** Entries must be lodged through suncoastchess@gmail.com

No later than Friday 17th May.

Late entries can only be considered in special cases.

- **Registration:** 8.30 – 9am on the day.

Teachers/Coaches or Team Captains please register the arrival of your team and any late changes, from 8.30 on the day, at the venue.

- **Entry Fee** (approved by the Chess association of Queensland):

\$15 per player. Invoiced to the school, after the event.

- **Programme:** It is expected that play will begin at approx 9.15am. There is not an official lunch time, rather players eat between rounds.

- **Presentations:** Closing ceremony From 2pm. We encourage all players to stay and acknowledge winners, plus be present for special awards and random draw prizes.
